FINANCIAL UPDATE

Our current **average weekly income is £1,410** and comes from such sources as: standing orders (£300), envelopes (£70), and cash (£1040). This means that against a budget of £3,032 per week which is required, we have a shortfall of **£1,177**. If gift aid and rent (£1,177) are taken into account (which are very unpredictable), our shortfall each week will be in the region of **£450**. Last week's cash offering was **£994.00**
